



Once every nine years the Gateway PGA Section selects a member in good standing to represent PGA of America; District 7 on the National Board of Directors. This person will be expected to commit to four (4) years in this position. During the first year the member chosen will be an observer to the National process in which he or she will shadow the current District 7 Director. The next three (3) years he or she will serve his official term of Director on the National PGA Board of Directors.

As approved by the membership at the 2016 Gateway PGA Fall Membership Meeting, the following is an outline of the selection process and the bylaws that the Section will follow.

a. Nominations and Selection:

During the Section's selection year, nominations may be made in the months of June and July (prior to the November PGA Annual Meeting). During this time, Class A members in good standing may nominate themselves, other Class A members in good standing, or the Board of Directors may solicit Gateway PGA members in good standing who they feel possess the skills and abilities to represent District 7 on the National Board of Directors. During the month of August, prior to the upcoming PGA of America Annual Meeting, the Board of Directors will meet, vote, and announce its selection to the Section membership. The chosen candidate will be selected by a majority vote of the Board of Directors no later than August 31st prior to the PGA of America Annual Meeting.

b. More than one candidate:

If during the selection/nomination process the Board of Directors has more than one (1) candidate, all candidates will have the opportunity to make a ten (10) minute presentation to the members of the Board during a selection meeting at a date set by the Board. After all candidates have had the opportunity to make their presentation, the Board of Directors will vote and announce its recommendation to the Section membership.
